Master Thesis - General Information

You may apply for the master thesis 6 weeks at the earliest and 2 weeks at the latest before you wish to start, the date of receipt in the examination office being decisive.

You must have finished all modules except for the Advanced Methods in Cell Biology.

You will, however, get the official date to start your thesis only after submission of the grade for the oral exam of the Advanced Methods in Cell Biology thus having obtained the necessary 90 CP.

Internal Master Thesis (application at least 2 weeks before you wish to start):

The tutor and revisers should be lecturers who take part in the masters degree programme Physical Biology of Cells and Cell Interactions. For details see § 21 of the Study Regulations for PBioC published Sept. 1, 2015.

External Master Thesis (application at least 6 weeks before you wish to start):

Before submitting the application form you have to follow the procedure for external modules. It is advisable to conduct the preliminary module Advanced Methods in Cell Biology in the same group and prepare the informal application for both together.

The second reviewer has to be a professor taking part in the master programme PBioC.

The formal application of the external Master Thesis is subject to the same terms as the internal one.
