Methods and Sample



Ralf Martin Meyer

- 18 respondents
 - 6 narrative expert interviews with teachers (5 former police officers)
 - 9 written questionnaires with teachers (7 former police officers)
 - 3 narrative expert interviews with current drug squad officers
- Participative observations of political events
- Police representatives' statements published in the press (e.g. by the Hamburg police commissioner)



Objectives




- 1. Drug squad officers everyday-knowledge
- 2. Effective policing strategies from the police officers' point of view

The divided police


Dissociation of the principle of legality



1. To look the other way






