


Willingness to Participate

Do you think that that legalizing Hashish Use is a good idea?







Do Austrians accept the new Austrian Gambling Laws?



Approach

A we asked a convenience sample of 30 Austrians entering trains



Question


Equivalent Meaning


- The duration to gamble is <u>limited</u> to a maximum of 3 hours per day (81 % makes sense).
- Gamblers are <u>allowed</u> to gamble 3 hours per day without break (0 % makes sense).

Question

equivalent meaning

- The highest wager per game is <u>limited</u> to 1 Euro (79 % makes sense).
- Gamblers are now <u>allowed</u> to bet twice as much per game as before (1 Euro instead of 50 Cent) (0 % makes sense).
